Further researches after Miyasaka have changed the perspectives on the settlement.

The map below shows the distribution of the pit dwellings excavated ever in the Togariishi site and Yosukeone site. The red dots indicate the pit dwellings excavated by Mr. Miyasaka Fusakazu and also the black smaller dots indicate the hearths excavated by him. The hearths were possibly made on the floor of the pit dwellings, not made alone themselves, so they can be included into the number of the pit dwellings.

The green dots indicate the pit dwellings excavated by Chino City Board of Education. Those pit dwellings are counted much more than the number of those by Mr. Miyasaka and they are situated western area of the site. And the unearthed pottery includes the older types than those from his research in the chronology of the Jomon pottery.

Such results by those further excavation researches change the perspectives on the settlement of the Togariishi and Yosukeone site. Please check our view on the following two panels exhibited on the left.
